MIGRAINE ACTION PLAN

<u>Green Zone</u> (<u>Pt has no active symptoms)</u>	Use These Meds EVERY DAY or as Directed (Controller Medications)
Headache symptoms are minimal (occur only occasionally) Controller Meds: Abortive Meds:	1. Topamax 25 mg by mouth twice a day x 1 week then 50 mg twice a day2. Amitryptiline 75 mg by mouth at night3. Nifedipine 60 mg ER by mouth Q daily4. Venlafaxine ER 37.5 mg PO Q daily x 3 days then 75 mg PO Q daily5. Propranolol 10 mg daily5. Propranolol 10 mg daily6. Aimovig 70 mg Subcutaneous once monthly
Yellow Zone (Caution) Severe Migraine attach that is affecting daily functioning (work, school, life) Migraine severe and not under control with controller medicine and occasional abortive agents	Give medications in the Green Zone as usual PLUS 1. First, Naproxen 500 mg by mouth x 1 and Phenergan 25 mg by mouth x1 and go to Dark room with decreased light and sound Naproxen 500 mg by mouth every 8 hours PRN HA Phenergan 25 mg by mouth every 8 hours PRN N/V associated with HA 2 Second, Sumatriptan 100 mg by mouth x 1 at HA onset, and may repeat in 2 hours if HA recurs OR Maxalt 10 mg by mouth x 1 at HA onset, and may repeat in 2 hours if HA recurs 3 Third, Midrin 2 tabs by mouth x 1 then one to two tabs every 12 hours (max dose is 6 tablets in 24 hours) OR Lortab 7.5/500 1 tab by mouth x 1 and may use every 8 hours as needed If you have Yellow Zone symptoms that continue more than 24 hours, make appointment to see your doctor in AM or go
Red Zone (Medical Alert) Migraine is nonstop and associated with new onset symptoms unusual to you and different from prior Migraine Doctors Signature:	Give these medications immediately and seek Medical attention immediately 1 Sumatriptan 100 mg by mouth x 1 OR Maxalt 10 mg by mouth x 1 2. If symptoms do not resolve, then GO DIRECTLY to ER Call your Doctor and let him know that you are having these
